



D240 Discontinued

Further to the issue of Technical Bulletin 900517 on the 29th September, the residual stocks of D240 material have now been exhausted.

Therefore we now have to move on to the new D250 frame.

This will take place with immediate effect

Having already withdrawn the 40mm track options from the principle Optima glazed partition systems and the 40mm door frames D340 and D440, we are now in a position to complete the process and replace the D240 door frame.

With effect from Monday 3rd October, the D240 frame will be replaced by the D250.

As you can see from these Designer's Guide extracts, the frame section is very similar and has simply been stretched to give it the 50mm face dimension. The standard frame widths will increase by 20mm to account for the extra girth.

Everything else remains the same – same pivot plates, same strike plates, same gasket and most importantly, same price.

The order templates have already been amended to reflect this change and the selection menu now includes the D250 option.

With effect from Monday 3rd October, please ensure you order the D250 frame in place of the now withdrawn D240.

A limited stock of D240 material will be retained for churn projects but will gradually be diminished and will be available only by special arrangement.
